





REGULARIZATION what employers have to do

The Italian or EU state employer or foreigner who holds a long-term EU residence permit can sign a new employment relationship or declare one illegally established with Italian or foreign citizens present on the national territory before 8 March 2020 in these sectors:

- agriculture, livestock and zootechnics, fishing and aquaculture and other related activities if it has a minimum taxable income of at least 30 thousand euros;
- assistance to people with pathologies or handicaps that limit self-sufficiency and domestic work for families if they have an annual income of not less than 20 thousand euros if there is only one income earner in the family or less than 27 thousand euros if there are more cohabitants in the family.

1st June – 15th August 2020 from 7.00 to 22.00
